

Backyard Borders - Style 7 Unassembled Fence Sections

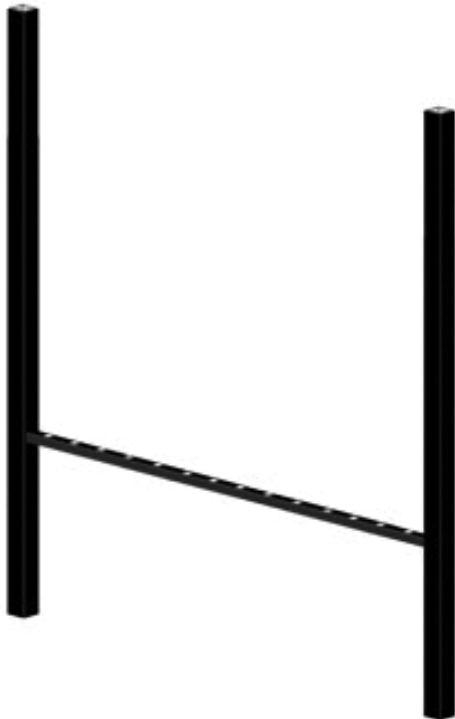
Tools Needed: Electric Drill, #2 Square Head Bit



Unassembled fence sections come complete and ready to assemble. Each fence section will include the following:

Style 7 - **36" height, 48" height, 54" height and 60" height:** 15 pickets per section, 1 rail with punched picket holes, 1 rail without holes, 45 square head self drilling screws.

Assembly



Step 1: Place 2 posts on a level flat surface with the routed rail holes facing each other. (If you did not purchase posts, please refer to the rail spacing on the specification drawings on the next page.)

Step 2: Insert the lower rail into the post holes. The lower rail is the rail with the punched picket holes.

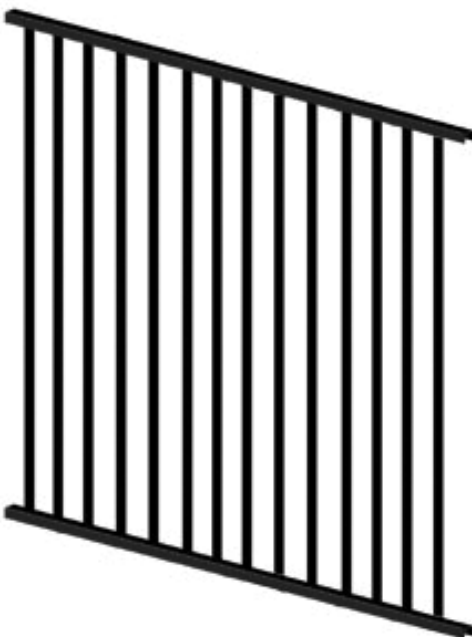
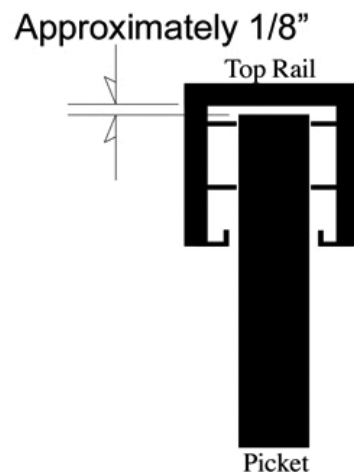


Step 3: Insert pickets into each picket hole.

Step 4: Once you have installed all of the pickets into the lower rail, insert the top rail into the posts.

Step 5: Be sure to push all pickets from the bottom into the top rail leaving approximately a 1/8" gap between the top of the picket and the rail.

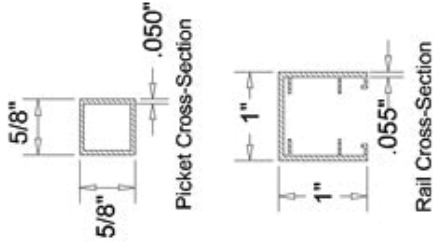
Step 6: Using an electric drill with a #2 square bit, screw each picket to the rails through the pre-drilled holes.



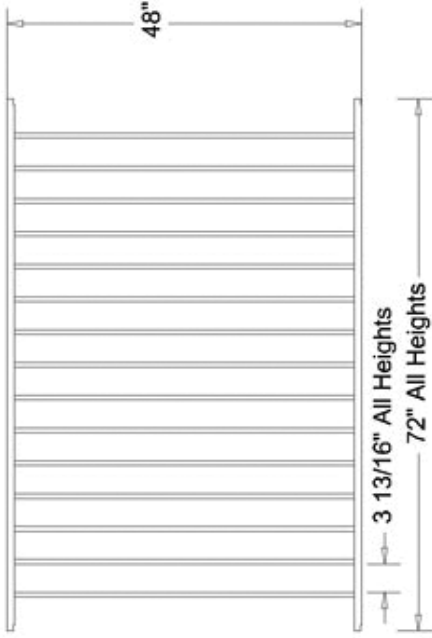
Step 7: Remove posts from ends.
